Waste management program

Our waste management plan is an action that promotes the achievement of waste management objectives. It focuses on reducing the amount of waste sent to a landfill site, by focusing on the Reduction, Reuse, Recycling and Revalorization of waste, as well as on changing the behavioral habits of

site users. Its fundamental objective is the elimination of the ultimate residue, i.e. that which cannot be reduced at the source.



To this end, we have in place:

- A data recording program related to our waste production rates of all types, as well as landfill diversion rates related to the various strategies adopted.
- An eco-centre for managing non-compostable waste destined for recycling, reuse, or reclamation, in accordance with standards.
- Policies for the management of waste from construction projects.
- A tenant communication program. Link 1350-1360 includes a section on the environment in each edition, including waste management.
- Policies for environmentally and socially responsible procurement.
- A supplier validation program to ensure that their company operates according to the same environmental values as GWLRA.
- We have re-started this year, a green committee that includes our tenants. The next meeting will be held in the fall and will touch upon the notion of accessibility.
